

Carpet Tiles Care & Maintenance

Unlike traditional deep pile carpet, carpet tiles are designed for practicality in busy environments, they are designed to resist spills and stains, but accidents do happen and as long as you act quickly, they are fast and easy to clean.

Carpet tiles can only perform if they are maintained properly; failure to do so can affect the life and appearance of the carpet tile.

- Regular vacuuming is essential; to keep your carpet tiles looking good.
- Spills should be cleaned quickly, blot the area with damp cloth; avoid using too much moisture during cleaning, many conventional carpet cleaning products can be used on carpet tiles, use in accordance with the product instructions.
- Take care when using solvents and check them on an unseen area first, when using cleaning solutions or solvents always apply them to the cloth or sponge you are using to clean with, not directly to the carpet.
- Blotting is advised over rubbing as rubbing tends to embed the stain making it more difficult to remove.
- Carpet tiles are easy to remove and replace, if an area becomes excessively soiled or worn, one or more tiles can simply be removed and replaced.
- Deep cleaning of your carpet tiles should always be done by a professional.
